CEO's Update

Wishing you a blessed, healthy holiday season as you are emerging out of the tough year with strength and grace.

As the year wraps up, I am happy to share Pragathi's commitment and support to other non-profit organizations including SODEWS and MyGOAL. Through your contributions and unwavering support, Pragathi continues to lead the way in social impact, supporting hundreds of children in receiving education and healthcare.

Between 2020 and 2021, Pragathi raised about \$21000 from donors and sponsors. Pragathi funded \$12000 to SODEWS and \$3000 to MyGoal Autism to continue their efforts in these challenging times.





SODEWS

Pragathi keeps in close touch with one of our grantees, SODEWS. This past year was one of many successes and progress for SODEWS students in spite of the pandemic impacting normal life. 113 children (including 35 girls) resided in the hostel. Students were given intensive training for public examinations. Examinations for the 12th grade are complete, 11th grade is near-complete, but Grade 10 examinations could not begin due to the pandemic.

Though students were sent home in March 2020, construction projects were able to continue with government approval and the school boundary wall is near complete.

WORK IN THE COMMUNITY

SODEWS has been providing relief to affected local residents by supplying dry rations. Over 4500 families have been provided food. With corporate sponsorship SODEWS has been able to support staff, many of who come from struggling circumstances themselves.

SODEWS notes the support of patrons and donors has made the work supporting the community possible. In addition, SODEWS participated in the construction of 11 homes for people affected by the Gaja Cyclone.
